The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to take strict legal action against respondents No.5 & 6 on the basis of complaint dated 09.02.2023 with further prayer to provide protection to the life and liberty of the petitioner as well as his family members at the hands of respondents No.5 & 6, who are issuing threats of elimination and implication in false criminal cases.

After having perused the petition, wherein a complaint is dated 09.02.2017, till date after almost three months, petitioner is under no threat whatsoever and is living peaceful life without any hindrance or any obstruction to his life and enshrined under Article 21 of Constitution of India, therefore, prima facie no case is made out of any alleged threat perception.

As far as prayer with regard to the direction to take action on the complaint dated 09.02.2023 is concerned, Mr. Rajiv Verma, DAG, Punjab,

appearing on advance notice informs the Court that the petitioner is a habitual offender and involved in multiple cases of illegal mining and during the course of naka laid down by the police, the petitioner, who was inebriated condition was stopped therein and a minor scuffle took place between the petitioner and the police official, who got admitted himself in the hospital with minor bruises, was discharged in the morning itself. A case bearing FIR No.0023 dated 09.02.2023, under Sections 353, 332 and 186 of IPC, has been registered at Police Station Dharamkot and the complaint dated 09.02.2023 is the counter blast of the said FIR.

Heard.

The present petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga to look into the complaint dated 09.02.2023 (Annexure P-2) and decided the same with a period of two week from today thereafter, a copy of order so passed shall be supplied to the petitioner.

Ordered accordingly.
