Prayer in this petition is to quashing FIR No.186, dated 05.12.2019 (Annexure P-1), registered at Police Station Mataur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, under Section 506 of IPC and Section 66 of the Information Technology Act, 2000 and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

It is contended by learned counsel that FIR was lodged on account of matrimonial dispute. Apart from this FIR, many other cases were pending amongst the parties. All those disputes stand settled by way of mediation held before this High Court. Copy of that settlement/compromise is Annexure P-2. Based thereon, other cases have already been withdrawn. Attention is also drawn towards order dated 27.03.2023 passed by this Court in CRM-M-15004-2023. Annexure P-9 is the copy of another order dated 25.04.2023 passed in CRM-M-13570-2023, whereby another FIR No.57, dated 27.03.2018, registered at Police Station Mataur, District S.A.S. Nagar, under Sections 452, 323, 148, 149 and 506 of IPC, was quashed on the basis of compromise.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Parneet Singh Pandher, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on

behalf of respondent No.1-State. Mr. Jagdish Manchanda and Gurpreet

Jayia, Advocates has filed Vakalatnama on behalf of respondent No.2. Counsel for respondent No.2 concedes the factum of compromise and has no objection for quashing of FIR in question.

In view of the abovesaid circumstances, particularly the fact that the compromise has been effected between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this High Court, FIR No.186, dated 05.12.2019 (Annexure P-1), registered at Police Station Mataur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, under Section 506 of IPC and Section 66 of the Information Technology Act, 2000 and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2), are quashed.
