1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to determine and release pension of the petitioner as per 6th and 7th Central Pay Commission.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that petitioner after serving for more than 24 years sought voluntary retirement on 31.12.1988. The petitioner was granted pension. The petitioner even today is getting pension, however, pension of the petitioner has not been calculated/revised in accordance with recommendation of 6th and 7th Central Pay Commission. The respondent No.3 vide communication dated 19.01.2022 has forwarded claim of the petitioner to respondent No.2, however, despite passing of sufficient time no order has been passed.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents who on advance notice is present in Court assures the Court that competent authority would look into the grievance of the petitioner and pass an appropriate order.
4. In view of statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondents to determine claim of the petitioner within 3 months from today.
