Prayer in this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.02, dated 07.01.2019, registered at Police Station Rori, District Sirsa, under Sections 489-B and 489-C of IPC.

Trial is pending in the Court of learned Sessions Judge, Sirsa. Petitioner was on bail. He absented from trial on 15.02.2023 and so his bail was cancelled and bonds were forfeited. Warrants of arrest were issued against him for 11.04.2023, on which date, report was received that his son disclosed that petitioner used to work on combine and had gone out of station for harvesting. It is submitted by counsel for the petitioner that petitioner had gone to Gujarat for harvesting being a driver of Combine Machine and could not reach Sirsa in time as Combine Machine was struck down on the way.

Mr. Randhir Singh, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petitioner is hereby directed to surrender before the Trial Court on or before 31.05.2023. On his such appearance, the Trial Court may initiate

proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C. against the petitioner and on disposal thereof, it will enlarge the petition on bail. If in the meantime, petitioner is sought to be arrested, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of arresting officer.
