SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioners prays for, and, is permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition. However, with liberty to move an application before the Competent Authority but in terms of the relevant rules, contemplating the alienation of the petition lands to the petitioners.
2. Consequently, the extant writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, but with liberty to the petitioners to within a week from today move an application before the Gram Panchayat concerned, who on receiving the said application, may consider to pass a resolution with respect to transfer of the petiton lands to the petitioners, and, thereafter shall forthwith make its transmission, for its further processing, to the approving authority concerned.

3. The approving authority concerned, on receiving the said resolution, shall make a speaking decision thereon, but after hearing all affected persons concerned, yet positively within a period of one month from its receiving the same.
