By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, prayer has been made for issuance of direction to respondent No.4 to register FIR against the private respondents i.e. respondents No.6 to 10 in pursuance to complaint filed by the petitioners.

Upon notice of motion, official respondents have filed their reply dated 29.11.2019 through the affidavit of Jashandeep Singh Gill, PPS. Assistant Commissioner of Police (South), Ludhiana, on behalf of respondent No.1 to 4.

Today, learned counsel for the petitioner apprises this Court of the fact that upon an inquiry conducted by the official respondents, an FIR

No.353 dated 11.12.2020 under Sections 420/120-B IPC has been registered against respondents No.5 to 7 at Police Station Division No.5, Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana, and the investigation is going on for the past two years. Learned counsel further submits that investigating agency is taking undue long period for concluding the investigation in the aforementioned FIR.

On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that all sincere efforts are being made to conclude the investigation. Upon instructions from ASI Balkaran Singh, he further submits that the final report shall be submitted before the Illaqa Magistrate within a period of 8 weeks from today.

In view thereof, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the official respondents to submit the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. before the Illaqa Magistrate within a period of 8 weeks from today.

Disposed of accordingly.
