The petitioner has approached this Court stating that her life and liberty is at danger and the respondents are directed to protect her life and liberty.

The allegations are about to be only called and without any basis as per the representation made by the petitioner to Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala. It seems that earlier she left her matrimonial house and is living separately. The house was provided to her with the help of one property dealer. It is also stated that her husband is a hard core addict and habitual criminal. No mention about the number of cases pending against him has been made in the representation or as said.

Be that as it may, this Court in 482 Cr.P.C. would not entertain complaints and directing the cases to be registered. The courses available to the petitioner either to approach the concerned Police Station or to the concerned Magistrate.

Petition is dismissed.
