By way of this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C, petitioner has prayed for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.0277 dated 31.12.2022 registered under Sections 307, 323, 341, 506, 148, 149, 120-B IPC and Section 25 and 27 of Arms Act, at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that fire-arm injury attracting Section 307 IPC is attributed to co-accused Prem Singh alias Premi. The only role attributed to the petitioner is that he had hit iron rod on the right leg of the complainant i.e. non vital part of the body attracting Section 325 IPC.

The afore-said factual position is not disputed by learned State Counsel. As per the custody certificate placed on record by learned State Counsel, petitioner is in custody for the last 06 months and 18 days, though he is involved in five more cases. It is also informed by learned State Counsel that though challan has already been filed but charges are yet to be framed.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.
