Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the petitioner has already joined at the transferred station, hence, the petitioner may kindly be given liberty to file appropriate representation for consideration of the department with regard to difficulties being faced by the petitioner qua the impugned order of transfer, so as to withdraw the same and the respondents be directed to decide the said representation in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondent-State submits that in case a representation is received from the petitioner raising any grievance, the same will be disposed of in accordance with law by passing appropriate speaking order within a period of six weeks of receipt of the same.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
