Counsel for the respondents has filed the affidavit of the Sub-Divisional Officer, Operation, Sub-Division Babyal, District Ambala, to submit that the petitioner had applied for a new agricultural power supply connection for tubewell as per his application dated 01.12.2017 with an undertaking to abide all the rules and regulations of the Nigam and HREC.

Counsel for the respondents has further submitted that thereafter, a demand notice was issued for deposit of Rs.30,000/- and given the consent for the new connection. It is further stated that again on 08.05.2023, a notice is given to the petitioner that the electricity connection will be released immediately on completion of all the formalities on deposit of estimate costs of Rs.81,343/-.

Counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Raj Singh, XEN, has argued that on deposit of the estimate costs, the connection will be released within a period of two weeks.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to avail the alternative remedy in accordance with law, if so advised.
