1. Present writ petition has been filed for issuance of directions to respondents to promote the petitioner to the post of District Fisheries Officer w.e.f. December 2013 or in alternative from February 2014 i.e. from the date when he became eligible to be promoted to a Group-B post alongwith all consequential benefits.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised through representation dated 21.03.2022 (Annexure P-3) submitted to respondents and the same is still

pending consideration before the authorities concerned and the petitioner will be satisfied if a time bound direction is given to respondents/competent authorities to decide the above representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

3. Notice of motion to respondents.

4. Mr. Pankaj Middha, Addl. A.G. Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of State of Haryana-respondents No.1 and 2 and raises no objection for deciding the representation in a time bound manner.

5. Learned State counsel submits that in case the said representation dated 21.03.2022 (Annexure P-3) has not already been decided by respondents so far, the same will be considered and decided within a period of eight weeks from receipt of certified copy of this order and in case after the decision of representation, any benefit accrues, the same will also be extended to the petitioner within a period of four weeks thereafter.

6. Keeping in view the statement made by the learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.

7. Ordered accordingly.
