SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. Given the statement made, at the bar, by the learned counsel for the petitioner, that Annexure P-2, thus ordering for eviction of the respondents concerned, from the panchayat land(s), hence has acquired finality and conclusivity. Therefore, reserving to the petitioners, the remedy of instituting an apposite execution petition, before the learned Collector concerned, the instant petition is closed, thus in view of the above available alternative remedy, rather for ensuring an efficacious execution of Annexure P-2.

2. In view of the above, the instant petition is disposed of, with liberty to the petitioners herein, to forthwith institute an execution petition, before the learned Collector concerned, who shall, on receiving such an execution petition, if not already filed, make appropriate orders thereons, and, after ensuring the issuance of warrants of possession, if not

already issued, he shall on return of such warrants of possession, ensure the recordings of objective satisfaction, that the completest execution of Annexure P-2, thus has been made.

3. However, in the above procedure, the learned Collector concerned, shall give an opportunity of hearing to the judgment debtors concerned.
