1. This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents especially respondent No.2 to stop the further proceedings regarding notice dated 09.03.2023 (Annexure P-3).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since no order under Section 20 of the Punjab Panchayati Raj Act, 1994 has been passed against the petitioner, thus, he seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to pursue the case before the authorities.
