The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.264 dated 10.9.2020 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station, Sector 13-17, Panipat.

By virtue of the order dated 5.7.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
