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SANJIV BERRY, J.

This is a petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for quashing of FIR No. 0044 dated 30.01.2020 under Sections 279, 337 IPC and Sections 146 and 196 of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988, registered at Police Station Sampla, District Rohtak (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 24.04.2023 (Annexure P-2) executed between the parties.

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[2]. With the intervention of respectables and elderly people of the society, the parties have arrived at a settlement vide compromise deed dated 24.04.2023 (Annexure P-2), which is duly signed by them. The matter was referred to the Court below for recording of statements of the parties and to report with respect to genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the parties. Learned Civil Judge (Jr. Division)-cum-JMIC, Rohtak, vide report dated 20.07.2023 has apprised this Court that the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and without any pressure.

[3]. Respondent No. 2 is represented by his counsel and does not oppose the compromise.

[4]. In view of the aforesaid report of the dated 20.07.2023, of the learned Civil Judge (Jr. Division)-cum-JMIC, Rohtak and in view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in "Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another", 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and "Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another", (2014) 6 SCC 466, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping with the criminal proceedings pending, since the complainant/respondent No.2 has himself compromised the dispute with the petitioner/ accused person.

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[5]. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 0044 dated 30.01.2020 under Sections 279, 337 IPC and Sections 146 and 196 of the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988, registered at Police Station Sampla, District Rohtak (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner on the basis of compromise dated 24.04.2023 (Annexure P-2).
