Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.88 dated 04.07.2021, under Sections 306, 304-B and 498 of IPC, registered at Police Station Dayalpura, District Bathinda.

Vide order dated 29.09.2021, this Court while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail directed the petitioners to join investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Mander Singh states that the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation are no longer required.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

In view of above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 29.09.2021 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners, is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
