Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of the impugned criminal complaint bearing NACT No.152 of 22.04.2022 and impugned summoning order dated 22.04.2022 vide which the petitioner has been summoned to face trial.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail alternative remedies before the trial Court as available under law.

Allowed to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is 85 years of age and due to his ill-health, he is unable to attend the Court and he may be granted exemption from appearance before the trial Court.

Heard. Learned trial Court is directed to consider the application sympathetically if filed by the petitioner for grant of

exemption from his personal appearance during trial. The trial Court is free to impose any condition which it likes, in case it allows the application.
