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Mr. Karandeep Singh Dargan, Advocate has put in
appearance on behalf of the appellants and filed power of attorney,
which is taken on record.

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the
appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately
recorded, a sum of Rs.2,50,000/- over and above the amount already
awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellants. Learned
counsel further submitted that the entire enhanced amount be paid to
appellant No.2-Gurinder Singh S/o Sukhdev Singh @ Sukha, for & on
behalf of all the appellants, in full & final satisfaction of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the
Insurance Company to deposit cheque in the sum of Rs.2,50,000/-
favouring appellant No.2-Gurinder Singh S/o Sukhdev Singh @
Sukha, with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within six
weeks from today. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per
annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this
order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the
office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the
cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
