VIVEK PURI, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking to quash the FIR No. 06 dated 31.03.2021 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Women, District SAS Nagar Mohali on the basis of compromise.

2. As per the report received from the learned trial Court, none of the parties had appeared in the Court despite sufficient opportunities to get the statement recorded.

3. At the first instance, the parties were directed to get their statements recorded by appearing before the learned Illaqa/Duty Magistrate in terms of the order dated 22.05.2023. The report was received to the effect that the parties had not appeared before the trial Court to get the statements recorded. Thereafter, in terms of the order dated 29.08.2023, it was submitted that the petitioner is working in Private Sector in the State of Karnataka and another opportunity was sought to get the statement recorded in the trial Court. Now, again the report has been received to the effect that none had appeared to get the statement recorded.

4. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn.
