The petitioners herein seek direction to the respondents to enroll the services of the petitioners on the roll of Municipal Council, Yamuna Nagar or that of Haryana Kaushal Rozgar Nigam Limited as per instructions dated 21.09.2021 (Annexure P-5) and 14.04.2022 (Annexure P-6).

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied in case their representations dated 23.12.2022 (Annexure P-7) and dated 23.12.2022 (Annexure P-8), ventilating their grievance, whereupon no decision has been taken as yet, are decided in a time bound manner, in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Anant Kataria, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

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Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper-book be supplied to him, during the course of day.

In view of the limited prayer made, without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.3 and 5 to decide the representations dated 23.12.2022 (Annexure P-7) and 23.12.2022 (Annexure P-8) respectively, as per policy, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and convey the decision to the petitioners. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
