Petitioner has filed this petition praying for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect his life, liberty and property which is in eminent danger at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6, with further prayer to take suitable action on the representation dated 24.02.2016 (Annexure P-1) filed by the petitioner.

After issuance of notice, respondents No.3 and 4 have filed their respective replies by way of affidavit of Mr. Sant Singh Dhaliwal, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Anandpur Sahib, District Roopnagar, Punjab (on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3) and Mr. Tejinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (Hq.), Rupnagar, District Rupnagar, Punjab on behalf of respondent No.4.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jarnail Singh, has submitted that the case pertains to protection being sought by the petitioner way back in 2016 and as per the instructions received, the parties have compromised the matter by way of amicable settlement.

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After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, this Court finds that the State has acted on the complaint filed by the petitioner and the dispute was resolved. However, even if the petitioner has any grievance regarding protection of his life and liberty, he is at liberty to approach the concerned authorities with the detailed representation and the respondent-State would deal with the same if any representation is filed in accordance with law. Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
