Petitioner is praying for regular bail in case FIR No.03, dated 09.01.2023, registered at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar, under Sections 302, 307, 353, 186, 216 and 120-B of IPC, besides Sections 25 & 27A of the Arms Act, 1959.

It is contended by counsel for the petitioner that during the entire incident, petitioner is nowhere in the picture. The only role attributed to him is that he helped co-accused in taking shelter.

Notice of motion.

Mr. M.S. Nagra, Asstt. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. The factual position as described by learned counsel for the petitioner, is not disputed by learned State counsel.

As per custody certificate placed on record by learned State counsel, petitioner is in custody for the last 4 months and 10 days. He has no criminal antecedent.

Heard.

Having regard to the role attributed to the petitioner in the crime, but without commenting anything further upon the merits of the case, the petitioner is admitted to regular bail and he is ordered to be

released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court concerned.
