Present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India claiming that the statutory appeals filed by the petitioners are pending with the appellate authority since 22.08.2022.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners at the outset prays for deciding the appeals filed by the petitioners dated 22.03.2023 (Annexures P-2 and P-3) expeditiously by passing a speaking order within a time bound frame.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Anil Sharma, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. He submits that the appeals filed by the petitioners shall be decided expeditiously.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.

6. The appellate authority-respondent No.2 is directed to consider and decide the appeals dated 22.08.2022 (Annexures P-2 and P-3), in

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accordance with law, by passing a speaking order as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

7. Since the statutory appeals are still pending and yet to be decided, it will be in the interest of justice that no further recovery be effected from the petitioner.
8. The petition stands disposed off.
