The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to direct respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

Status report by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad has been filed on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 3-State in Court today and the same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel submits that petitioner No.1 was a minor girl and has been kept at the Child Welfare Committee, Fatehabad. Now the Child Welfare Committee, Fatehabad has handed over to the custody of petitioner No.1 to Child Welfare Committee, Faridkot. Apart from that, an FIR No.614 dated 21.11.2023, under Sections 363, 366 of IPC, at Police Station Sadar, Fatehabad has been registered against petitioner No.2 and he has been arrested in the present case.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further directions are required and the same is ordered to be disposed of.
