1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.90 dated 04.05.2023 under Sections 323 of the IPC and Section 75 of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015 registered at Police Station Rewari Sadar, District Rewari.

2. As per allegations levelled in the FIR (Annexure P-1), the petitioner was director of the school, where the son of the complainant was studying. On 04.05.2023, the petitioner mercilessly beat up the son of the complainant.

3. On the last date of hearing i.e. 19.05.2023, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked him to join investigation.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions, has submitted that in compliance of order dated 19.05.2023, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on

further instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 19.05.2023, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
