While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed
on 18.05.2023:-

“It is submitted that the allegation against the petitioner in the FIR is similar to that made against co-accused Koyal @ Mohini, who has been granted interim bail by this Court. Moreover, the petitioner is not related with the accused persons and has been falsely implicated.

Notice of motion for 02.08.2023.

Mr. Kamalpreet Bawa, AAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and waives service.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join investigation with the Investigating Officer on 25.05.2023 at 10.00 a.m. and co-operate therewith. In the event of his arrest, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/SHO concerned subject to his joining the

investigation and compliance of the provisions enshrined under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard alongwith 24451-2023.”

2. Today, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Paramjit Singh, has stated that pursuant to the order dated 18.05.2023, the petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.
3. In view of above, the interim order dated 18.05.2023 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to the conditions as enumerated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
4. Petition stands disposed off.
