1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to direct the respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners as they apprehend imminent threat at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 7.

2. In pursuance to the notice issued to the respondents, a short reply by way of an affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana has been filed by the State of Punjab. Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner No. 2 has made a statement that petitioners are residing together peacefully and now they do not apprehend threat from anyone. Even, the local police has conducted the investigation in the matter and found that the apprehension expressed by both the petitioners is without any basis.

In view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, no further directions are required and the petition is, accordingly, disposed off.
