Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus in the form of direction to the respondent-authorities to release the revised pay arrears of the 6th Pay commission w.e.f. July, 2021 to September 2022.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners at the outset confines his prayer for deciding legal notice dated 17.04.2023 (Annexure P-3). He submits that at this stage, petitioners would be satisfied, if the said representation/legal notice is decided by passing a speaking order within a time bound frame.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and Mr. H.S. Batth, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.3 and submits that respondent No.3/competent authority will look into the

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matter and will take a decision on the claim raised by the petitioners in the representation/legal notice, in accordance with law.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.

6. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioners in the present petition, respondent No.3-Competent Authority is directed to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice dated 17.04.2023 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, the petitioner is found entitled, his claim be released within a period of six weeks thereafter. In case, the respondents are of the opinion that the claim of the petitioner merits rejection the same be adjudicated upon by passing a speaking order after giving an opportunity of personal hearing to the petitioner within the time as stipulated hereinabove.

7. The petition stands disposed off.
