1. The petitioner has come before this Court challenging his transfer order from Sri Muktsar Sahib to Sub Centre Dodhar, PHC Dhudike, District Moga.

2. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner had submitted representations to the Senior Medical Officer apprehending injury and financial loss to him by the staff members of the concerned Sub Centre, where he was posted in Sri Muktsar Sahib, vide representations dated 29.08.2022 and 03.10.2022. The petitioner had preferred a writ petition seeking a prayer from this Court to direct the respondents to decide his representation and this Court disposed of the writ petition by directing the respondents to consider and decide the representation by passing reasoned order.

3. Learned counsel submits that no speaking order was passed and instead the petitioner was transferred from Sri Muktsar Sahib to District

Moga, which is 200 km away. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner should have been transferred nearby to some other place.

4. I have considered the submissions.

5. This Court finds that the petitioner has actually been granted the relief by transferring him to another district, as there was apprehension of personal injury and financial loss from some persons, who had been threatening to implicate him and his family members in some false cases at Sri Muktsar Sahib. Learned counsel frankly admits that after the petitioner was transferred and since he has joined, no incident of that nature has occurred.

6. In the circumstances, no interference is warranted in the transfer order and the writ petition is wholly misconceived. The same is accordingly dismissed.

7. All pending misc. application(s) also stand disposed of.
