1. Counsel for the petitioner pleads no instructions.
2. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. directed against order dated 31.01.2015 passed by JMIC, SBS Nagar, whereby the petitioner was declared 'Proclaimed Offender' in FIR No.33 dated 02.04.2014, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 324 and 34 of IPC at Police Station Sadar SBS Nagar (Nawanshahr).
3. On 22.12.2017, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner was not aware about the pendency of FIR No.33 dated 02.04.2014 under Sections 323, 324, 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station S.B.S. Nagar (Nawanshahr) and, therefore, under this impression, he had gone abroad i.e. Saudi Arabia. However, now the petitioner has returned on 22.07.2017 and is ready to face trial in accordance with law, provided he is protected from arrest.

Notice of motion for 21.02.2018.”

4. Now more than 06 years have elapsed, there is no interim order and the whereabouts of the petitioner are also not known.
5. In view of above, present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
