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**JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (ORAL)**

The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.92 dated 31.05.2022 registered under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Industrial Area, Chandigarh.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 13.06.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation, no case for custodial interrogation is made out.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 13.06.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on

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joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
