1. Through the present petition, the petitioners seek issuance of directions to the respondents to permit them to continue in service on contract basis on their respective posts of Data Entry Operator against the sanctioned vacant posts as according to them, the work, for which they had been earlier appointed, still subsists.
2. On 22.05.2023, this Court had directed the learned State counsel to seek instructions as to whether the petitioners can be re-employed.
3. In pursuance to the directions given by this Court, learned State counsel submits that there is no work with the respondents against which the petitioners services can be continued.
4. In the light of the afore statement, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition.
5. Dismissed as not pressed.

6. It is clarified that for the days that the petitioners have actually discharged their duties for which their salary is due, the respondents shall release such salary within 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
