Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though the petitioners have already been granted the benefit of appointment but they intend to claim seniority in their cadre, hence, petitioners be given liberty to file an appropriate representation seeking benefit of appointment with retrospective effect so as to claim seniority, so that no prejudice is caused to them due to delayed appointment and further, respondents be directed to decide the said representation as expeditiously as possible.

Learned State counsel submits that in case any representation is received from petitioners, the respondent-department will decide the same in accordance with law by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of 8 weeks on receipt of any such representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as aforesaid.
