1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 20.04.2022 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Tribunal-cum-Additional District Magistrate, Malerkotla whereby application of respondent NO.2 under the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007 has been allowed and the petitioner and perform respondent No.5 have been ordered to be evicted from the residential house.
2. On 03.07.2023, fresh notice issued to respondent No.3 was received back unserved with the report that he is residing in Ludhiana. A perusal of the report would show that the fresh address of respondent

No.3 was not provided by the petitioner, thus, notice could not be issued.

3. Today, nobody has appeared on behalf of the petitioner although the matter has been called twice.

4. Dismissed for non-prosecution.

5. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an application for restoration of the present petition or to file a fresh petition in case any cause survives.
