The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 to 4 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in the case bearing FIR No. 0027 dated 18.02.2018 under Sections 279 and 427 IPC registered at Police Station Phase-I, District SAS Nagar and to submit the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from H.C. Malkeet Singh, submits that on the conclusion of investigation, the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been submitted in the trial Court. Furthermore, the accused/respondent No.5 has been declared as proclaimed offender in the instant case. As such, the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the categorical assertion made by learned State counsel, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

As none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner, he shall be at liberty to move an application for revival of the petition within a period of three months, if the aforesaid assertion of learned State counsel is found to be factually incorrect.
