1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions for protection of life and liberty and to take necessary legal action in the FIR.
2. Status report by way of affidavit of William Jeji, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Dirba on behalf of the State has been taken on record.
3. Learned State counsel submits that FIR bearing No. 52 dated 19.04.2019 under Sections 363, 366-A IPC and Section 6 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, was registered at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur on the basis of the statement of the petitioner alleging that his daughter, aged about 17 years was forcibly taken by respondent No.4 on the false pretext of solemnizing marriage. He further states that respondent No.4 has been acquitted by the learned trial Court in terms of the order dated 24.04.2023 and the appropriate legal action in the matter has already been taken which has culminated in the acquittal of respondent No.4 and nothing survives in the petition.

4. Disposed of.

5. As none has joined the proceedings on behalf of the petitioner, the petitioner shall be at liberty to seek revival of the petition within three months in the event, the assertions as projected hereinabove are found to be factually incorrect.
