The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.62, dated 20.04.2023, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 34 of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station City Patti, District Tarn Taran.

Status report by way of affidavit dated 25.07.2023 of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Security & Court Coordination, District Tarn Taran, submitted by the learned State counsel in the Court, is taken on record.

Vide order dated 19.05.2023, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 19.05.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 19.05.2023 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
