DEEPAK MANCHANDA J. (ORAL)

The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No. 70 dated 16.05.2022 registered under Sections 15(c) and Section 27A (which was added later on) of the NDPS Act at Police Station Baragundha District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on the directions of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and is no more required for further investigation in the present case. It has also been contended that nothing is to be recovered from him.

On the other hand, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ajit Singh, submits that, though, the petitioner has joined investigation and the amount of 1.50 lacs is yet to be recovered but there is no evidence with regard to the same against the petitioner.

In view of the facts that the petitioner has joined the investigation, therefore, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 15.06.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
