This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent No.2 to take action against the respondents No.4 to 14 who have demolished the house of the petitioner and also directing them to pay the compensation to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after giving an appropriate representation to the concerned authorities and after giving full and better particulars and also after correctly translating the order dated 25.11.2022 (Annexure P-4).
