1. The present revision petition has been preferred impugning the order dated 23.05.2012 passed in Criminal Complaint No.94 of 27.11.2004 by the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Mansa, whereby the accused (petitioner herein) had been convicted under Section 498-A IPC for a period of one year with fine of Rs. 1,000/- and also the order dated 01.10.2013 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Mansa, upholding the order passed by the Court below.

2. During the pendency of the appeal, the parties have resolved their matrimonial dispute and entered into compromise. A report with regard to the compromise has been duly received from the learned District and Sessions Judge, Mansa, which is taken on record.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the compromise entered between the parties has been duly adhered to and the fact the parties have been granted a decree of divorce under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, on 07.02.2020 by the learned District Judge, Mansa. He further submits that due to the present conviction order, the petitioner has suffered immensely and he was suspended owing to the same.

4. After hearing learned counsel for the parties, coupled with the fact that the parties have entered into compromise and have already been granted the decree of divorce, the present petition deserves to be allowed.

5. In view of the above, the petition stands allowed and the impugned judgments and the order of conviction dated 23.05.2012 and 01.10.2013 are hereby set-aside.

6. All the pending misc.applications also stand disposed of, in view of the disposal of the main petition.
