Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing respondents no.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents no.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that petitioner no.1 major, however, petitioner no.2 is 17 years of age and have sought protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents no.4 to 6. They want to marry with each other, however, only after petitioner no.2 attains the age of majority. The petitioners have submitted representation dated 15.5.2023 (Annexure P-3).

Notice of motion to respondents no.1 to 3-State only.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with a direction to respondent no.2 i.e. S.S.P., Patiala to decide the representation at Annexures P-3 of the petitioners and grant them

protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them. This order would not be understood having expressed any opinion whatsoever by this Court on the validity of the relationship of the petitioners.
