1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in the above-captioned case.
2. Upon notice and after hearing learned counsel for the State, petitioners were directed to join investigation and were granted interim anticipatory bail, vide order dated 15.06.2023.
3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Surinder Pal, Police Station Salem Tabri, District Commissionerate Ludhiana, submits that in pursuance to the aforesaid order passed by this Court, petitioners have joined investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation. It is also submitted that *challan* has been presented and trial is pending for framing of charges.

4. In view of the above facts but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 15.06.2023 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners is made absolute, subject to the conditions specified in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
