[1] Challenge in the instant appeal is to the orders dated 25.04.2023 and 12.05.2023 passed by the learned Single Judge in CWP No.8574 of 2023 and CM No.8144-CWP-2023 in case titled as 'Raman Kumar versus State of Punjab and others' whereby the civil writ petition has been adjourned to 25.07.2023 and the application for interim stay moved by the petitioner of order/notice (Annexures P-5 & P-6), inviting applications for filling 521 vacancies of Fair Price Shops in District Amritsar, Punjab, has also been adjourned to be taken up for hearing along with the main case, which is fixed for hearing on 25.07.2023.

[2] After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the appellant prays for permission to withdraw the instant appeal with liberty to move an appropriate application before the learned Single Judge.

[3] The same is not opposed to by the learned DAG, Punjab.

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[4] Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the appellant, as well as learned DAG, Punjab, the instant appeal is permitted to be *withdrawn* with the liberty as prayed for. Needless to mention, in case, any such application is moved, learned Single Judge is requested to consider the same in accordance with law.
