The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for the quashing of order dated 01.10.2021 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana in case bearing CIS No.SC/35897/2013 titled as State versus Jagdeep Singh instituted on 01.02.2013 whereby the bail bonds of the petitioner were cancelled vide order dated 01.10.2021 and non-bailable warrants of the petitioner were issued.

On 19.07.2022, the following order was passed in this case:-

“The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was unable to appear on one date i.e. 01.09.2021. The petitioner has been facing trial from the year 2012 and has been appearing regularly in the Court. However, due to this one absence the impugned order dated 01.10.2021 was passed cancelling his bail. He submits that he is ready and willing to surrender before the Trial Court immediately.

Notice of motion for 03.11.2022.

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In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of 07 days from today and on his surrendering, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.”

Thereafter, the matter was adjourned and came up for hearing today.

The petitioner remains unrepresented even on second call.

In view of the above, the present petition is ordered to dismissed for non-prosecution. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to move an application for revival of the main petition in case any cause of action still subsists.
