ALOK JAIN, J. :

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 46 dated 22.05.2021 registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC at Police Station Women, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

Vide order dated 03.03.2022, this Court while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail directed the petitioner to join investigation.

Vide order dated 01.12.2022, the parties were directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court to explore the possibility of any amicable settlement.

As per the report of the Mediator, dated 11.01.2023, the matter between the parties has been settled amicably. As per the compromise, the parties have undertaken to abide by the terms and conditions of the

compromise and shall file an appropriate petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act on or before 15.02.2023.

In view of above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 03.03.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, with liberty to the parties to proceed in accordance with law and stay bound by the terms and conditions of the settlement arrived at between them. Liberty is granted to the parties to approach the Court in case either of the compromising party withdraws or violates the terms and conditions of the compromise.
