This criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and to restrain the private respondents No.4 to 9 to not to harass or interfere in the peaceful life of the petitioner.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from L/ASI Soniya, submits that despite having been called to the police station to inquire into the representation, Annexure P-1, the petitioner is not coming forth.
