1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned final result dated 04.03.2019 (Annexure P-11).

2. Learned State Counsel has submitted that in the present case, since, the petitioner has secured 53 marks whereas the cut off was at 55.4 marks and thus, assuming arguendo, if the benefit of the two questions i.e. question Nos.6 and 23 is extended to the petitioner then also, the petitioner would not reach muchless cross the cut off.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the same, he seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present Civil Writ Petition.
