1. The petitioner's application for impleadment in a pending suit has been dismissed by the trial Court vide order dated 19.04.2022. This revision petition has been filed to challenge the correctness of the aforesaid order. In the suit, the dispute is with respect to the inheritance of the property left behind by late Sh. Dapinder Singh. Two sons of Sh. Dapinder Singh have filed a suit against Sh. Amardeep Singh, the third son. The applicant claims that he is in possession of the property as a lessee under the Punjab Wakf Board. The trial Court has dismissed the application on the ground that the petitioner can file an independent suit.

2. The learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that there are certain agreements executed in favour of the petitioner by Sh. Amardeep Singh, the defendant.

3. Be that as it may.

4. As is evident, the plaintiffs are not seeking relief against the defendant. Moreover, the petitioner has failed to show as to how he is a necessary or proper party in the suit.

- 5. In view of the aforesaid facts, no ground to interfere is made out.
- 6. Dismissed accordingly.
- 7. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
