1. Petitioner has assailed the order dated 27.03.2018 (Annexure P-5) vide which he has been declared as proclaimed offender in case bearing FIR No. 425 dated 10.11.2017 registered under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 506 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Gandhi Nagar, Police Station Farakpur, District Yamuna Nagar.
2. Learned State counsel on instructions from Investigating Officer submits that on 27.05.2019, the petitioner had surrendered before learned Illaqa Magistrate and the petitioner along with co-accused have faced trial and have been acquitted by the learned trial Court in terms of judgment dated 08.07.2021. Consequently, the present petition has become infructuous.
3. In view of the submission made by learned State counsel, present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
4. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to move an application for revival of the petition within a period of three months, in the event, the aforesaid assertion is found to be factually incorrect.
