MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.67 dated 05.03.2019 under Sections 506 of the IPC and Section 3(2)(Va) and 4 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 registered at Police Station Civil Lines Sonipat.

2. On 23.03.2023, while noticing the following submissions made by learned State counsel, a Coordinate Bench of this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked him to join investigation:-

“Learned DAG on instructions from DSP Rajiv Kumar states that the petitioner has been found to be truthful in the polygraphy test conducted and that in the circumstances, he be directed to join investigation. Adjourned to 19.04.2023.”

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3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 23.03.2023, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 23.03.2023, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
